Here is your copy of the "Description of Touring Routes in New York State for the Interstate (I), Federal (US) and State (NY) Route Number Systems". It is issued to you because of your concern with this subject. Periodic update sheets will be furnished as changes in the systems are made and they will be distributed in the same manner as this copy.

The following systems changes are made in this issue and are effective January 1, 1970, except as noted below:

Interstate (I) System

I-78 is shortened to end at I-278. The remaining portions of I-78 are renumbered as I-878 and I-295.

I-87 is rerouted to traverse the New York State Thruway between Elmsford and Newburgh. The portion of I-87 between White Plains and Brewster is renumbered as I-684.

I-88 is a new interstate route between I-81 near Binghamton and US 4 in Troy following the alignment of the Susquehanna Expressway and Alternate Route 7.

I-278 is reassigned from the Sheridan Expressway to the Bruckner Expressway in the Bronx.

I-281 is renumbered as I-481.

I-295 replaces a portion of I-78 on the Clearview Expressway.

**I-481 is a new number assigned to replace I-281 between I-81 north of Nedrow and I-90 at Collamer. It is also a new number assigned to Relocated Route 57 between I-90 at Collamer and I-81 at North Syracuse.

**I-495 is deleted from the Mid-Manhattan Expressway.

**I-678 is extended southerly along the Van Wyck Expressway to the J. F. Kennedy Airport.

I-684 is a new number replacing I-87 between White Plains and Brewster.

**I-695 is a new number assigned to the proposed Queens Interboro Expressway.

I-787 is shortened to end at I-88 in Albany County instead of at US 4 in Rensselaer County.

**I-878 is a new number assigned to replace I-78 on the Cross Brooklyn Expressway and Nassau Expressway.

I-895 is a new number to replace I-278 on the Sheridan Expressway.

(** Portions of these assignments are pending final approval of the Bureau of Public Roads and AASHO).

State (NY) System

NY 2 is shortened to end at US 4.

NY 7B is deleted and the portion between Unadilla and North Franklin is renumbered NY 357.

NY 12C is deleted and portions renumbered as NY 291 and NY 365.

NY 17 is assigned to the new Southern Tier Expressway between Steamburg and Salamanca and between Waverly and Vestal.

NY 22 is shortened to end at US 1 in the Bronx.

NY 24 is shortened to end at NY 25, Hillside Avenue.

NY 25 is extended across the Queensboro Bridge to end at the F. D. R. Drive.

NY 25C is deleted.

NY 27 is extended westerly along the Gowanus Expressway and the Brooklyn Battery Tunnel to end at I-78 at the Holland Tunnel.

NY 27A is deleted in New York City.

NY 47 is extended on both ends of the Rochester Outer Loop to the Lake Ontario State Parkway on the west and Lake Road at Sea Breeze on the east.

NY 69 is shortened to end at NY 5A in Yorkville.

NY 145 is shortened to end at NY 23 at Cairo. This eliminates the route overlap with Route NY 23 between Cairo and Catskill.

NY 164 is a new number to replace a portion of NY 216.

NY 204 is extended easterly on the Rochester Airport Expressway to end at NY 47.

NY 205 is extended southerly to end at the new I-88.

NY 216 is shortened and portions renumbered as NY 164 and NY 292.

NY 283 is deleted.

NY 287 is deleted and renumbered as NY 365.

NY 291 is a new number to replace a portion of NY 12C.

NY 292 is a new number to replace a portion of NY 216.

NY 357 is a new number to replace a portion of NY 7B.

NY 378 is extended across the Menands Bridge to end at US 4 to replace a short portion of NY 2.

NY 400 is a new number assigned to the Aurora Expressway.

NY 401 is a new number assigned to the Genesee Expressway.

NY 417 is a new number assigned to replace former NY 17 between Steamburg and Salamanca.

NY 434 is a new number assigned to replace former NY 17 between the Broome-Tioga County line and NY 26 in Vestal.

NY 437 is a new number assigned to connect Routes NY 38 and 38A south of Auburn.

NY 481 is a new number assigned to Relocated Route 57 between I-81 at North Syracuse and NY 3 in Fulton and is a continuation of I-481.

It is expected that the above changes will be reflected in future editions of road maps and the necessary sign changes will be made as expeditiously as possible where the changes affect highways now opened to traffic. Some of the numbers have been assigned to highways to be built in the future.
